Tuneful Picnic!

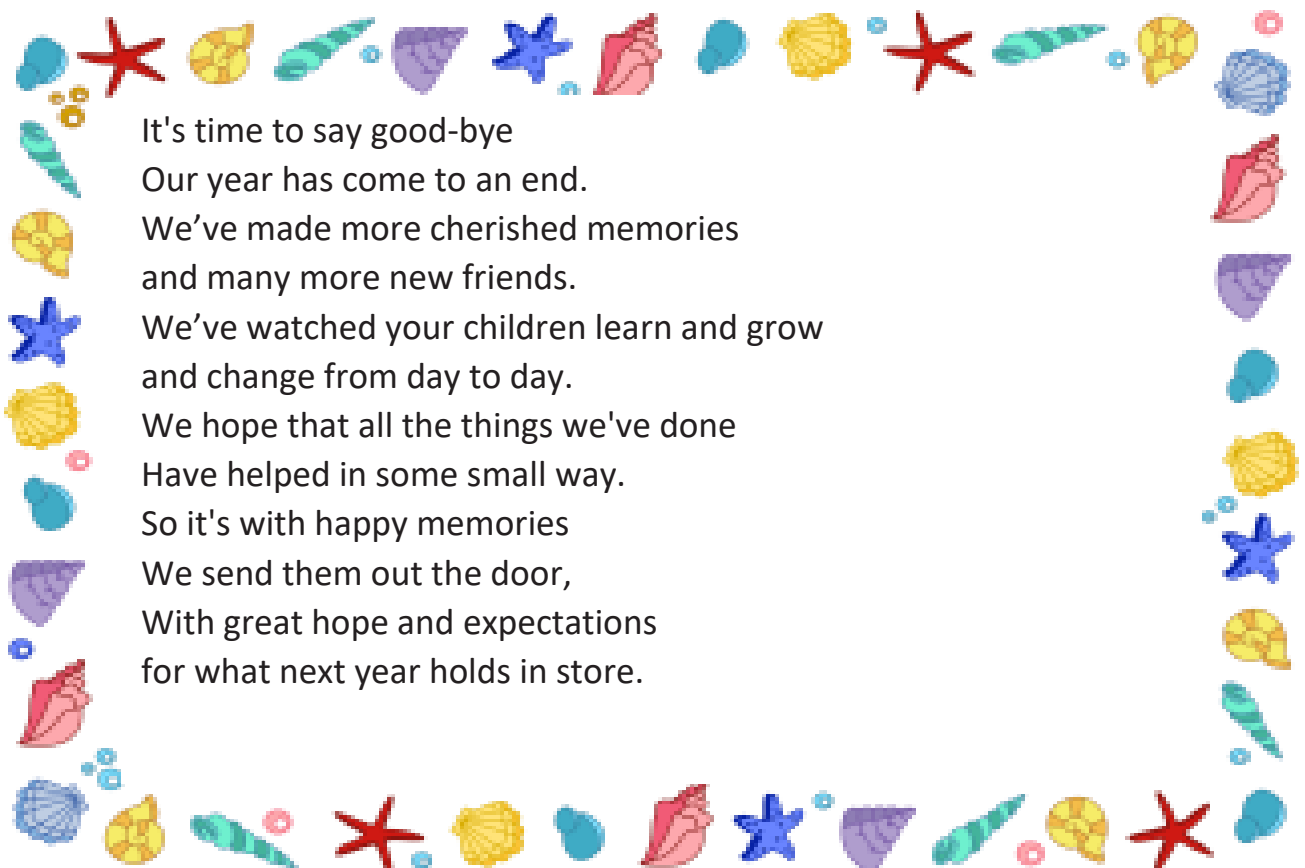
Wednesday 17th July 11.15-12.45
