

NURSERY ADMISSIONS APPLICATION – SEPTEMBER 2020 INTAKE

Dear Parents/Carers,

Since September 2018 Hertfordshire County Council have no longer offered an online system of applying for your child's preferred Nursery place.

If your child was born between 1st Sep 2016 and 31st Aug 2017 parents/carers will need to apply directly to the setting/s of their choice.

In partnership with other Watford schools, Kingswood Nursery School will adhere to the following timetable when dealing with admissions.

Deadline to apply to your chosen school/s	Friday 28th February 2020 – 9am
Offer letters sent by schools to parents/carers	Monday 9th March 2020 (Offer made by email or sent 1st class post)
Deadline to accept place and return paperwork to chosen school	Friday 20th March 2020 – 9am <i>Applications received after this date will be classed as 'late' applications.</i>

Kingswood Nursery Class has an admission number of 80 places. Kingswood is a maintained Nursery School, open term time only from 8.30-3.30pm Monday to Friday.

Kingswood Nursery School is funded by the Local Authority and is staffed with qualified teachers and early years practitioners.

We are an inclusive school, dedicated to working in partnership with parents and a network of professionals from other disciplines to ensure the best outcomes for all our children. There are numerous opportunities for parents to be involved in their child's education. We pride ourselves on being approachable, caring and dedicated.

Kingswood had an Ofsted inspection in March 2017 (<https://reports.ofsted.gov.uk/inspection-reports/find-inspection-report/provider/ELS/117076>) which stated:

'This is an Outstanding School'

'Kingswood Nursery is a special place to learn. Children are happy and they learn very well because they greatly enjoy all the stimulating and exciting activities.'

Kingswood will operate a single intake in September, enabling children to take up their nursery place in the September following their third birthday. Occasionally, subject to availability, children may be invited to attend the nursery sooner than this date, though always in the term after their third birthday. Attendance at Kingswood Nursery Class is either 5 mornings (8.30-11.30) or 5 afternoons (12.30-3.30).

When children are offered a place in the nursery class parents are asked for their preference for a morning or afternoon place, but there is no guarantee that they will be offered the session they prefer. There is no right of appeal for morning or afternoon places.

- A morning place is from 8.30-11.30am
- An afternoon place is from 12.30-3.30pm
- Kingswood has a lunch club from 11.30-12.30pm. The charge for this additional care is £5 and children bring a packed lunch from home.
- Kingswood can offer additional wraparound care in 3-hour blocks of time (to top up the free 15 hours) to enable your child to stay all day. The charge for this is £15 + £5 lunch club charge. Total charge £20 for 4 hours.
- Kingswood can offer 30 hours of free education if parents/carers meet the criteria (see Admissions Policy for full details) and check your eligibility at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk
- Kingswood will work in partnership with other providers to share the 30-hour entitlement.

Admissions Rules and Oversubscription Criteria

The following **Admission Rules and Oversubscription Criteria** for applying for a nursery place at Kingswood will be used. The rules will be applied in order. (Please refer to Nursery Admissions Policy October 2018 for further details which can be found on our website under 'Policies').

Parents must apply direct to the school office for a place for their child and these will be allocated following the school's criteria as set out below, providing applications have been received before the deadline.

Rule 1: EHC Section 324 of the Education Act 1996 requires the governing bodies of all maintained schools to admit a child with an EHC (Education, Health and Care) Plan that names the school.

Rule 2: Children looked after by the local authority, including children who were previously looked after but were then adopted (or became subject to a child arrangement order or a special guardianship order).

Rule 3: A child 'at risk' - (or the sibling of a child 'at risk') who is the subject of an inter-agency child protection plan.

Rule 4: Medical or Social – needs children for whom it can be demonstrated that they have a particular medical or social need to go to the school.

A panel of governors will determine whether the evidence provided is sufficiently compelling to meet the requirements for this rule and must clearly demonstrate why it is the only school that can meet the child's needs.

Rule 5: Sibling Children who have a sibling on the roll of the school at the time of application.

Rule 6: Attends Kingswood Pre-School at the time of the nursery application.

Rule 7: Any other children, in order of date of application.

These rules are applied in the order they are printed above. If more children qualify under a particular rule than there are places available, then the next rule will be applied.

If there are fewer applications than places available all applicants will be admitted.

Please complete the application form and return to school by Friday 28th February 2020 – 9am at the latest.

Any applications received after this time will be classed as 'late' applications.

- All applications received will be processed during the week beginning 2nd March and the over subscription admission rules will be applied if necessary.
- An offer letter will be **emailed to you** on Monday 9th March, (in the order the applications were received). If an email address was not provided then a letter will be posted on Monday 9th March (1st class postage) to let parents know the outcome of their application.
- **Parents have until Friday 20th March 2020** to accept the offered place.
- Parents can request to be on a waiting list if Kingswood Nursery class is full.

NOTES TO PARENT - How the information on this form will be used:

By completing this form and signing the declaration you are agreeing for Kingswood Nursery School, if they are oversubscribed, to check whether your child's details meet the school's published admission rules and if he/she can be offered a nursery place. Any personal data collected will be treated as confidential under the principles of the General Data Protection Regulations, May 2018. We will not use the data for any other purpose, nor will we share your data with any third parties other than the Department for Education (for statutory reporting), Hertfordshire County Council departments who may from time to time send you advice, guidance and information relating to changes to early years provision and educational services that are relevant and/or of benefit to your child, and your local Family Centre who support the local authority by assisting families to access the services that children are entitled to.

Children who have been adopted from care or are subject to a special guardianship order or a child arrangements order: Eligibility will be based on your declaration that your child was formally a looked after child and on the evidence of their status e.g. a copy of the relevant order. This form and a copy of the relevant order should be seen by the school and they will confirm with Hertfordshire County Council that they have seen confirmation and enable a place to be offered under this criterion.

If Kingswood is over-subscribed and parents ask to remain on a waiting list, then documents will be retained. Otherwise, documents will be shredded after one month for un-successful applicants or parents who decide to withdraw their application.
