

Some of you may have seen the 'Just Giving' page for Fatima Boukhetala. This is her story:

'We're raising £6,500 to stop the bank repossessing my house'.

'18 months ago my husband tragically died of an inoperable brain tumour. He left behind me and his three children, now aged 2, 5 and 8. In the time before he passed he could not come to terms with his impending death and was not able to put his affairs in order. When he died all our savings were gone and everything we owned was solely in his name, the house, mortgage and car etc. For the last year I have had to fight to keep our house. I have been so scared it would be taken from us.

It has taken all this time due to some complications but finally the house is in my name and the bank have agreed a mortgage. I have to pay £6000 when I sign the mortgage on 25th March 2018. Unfortunately the bank will not add this amount to the mortgage offer. I was unable to get legal aid and had to pay a solicitor to help me get to this stage. I have no money left to pay this and I have nothing left to sell to raise the money.

Please help me to keep a roof over my children's head by donating what you can. I am asking for £6500 in total to cover all fees. I am desperate to raise this money so that the bank do not repossess our house. My children have lost enough'.

All three of the boys have been to Kingswood Nursery. Fethi, the boy's father and Fatima's husband, was a great supporter of Kingswood. Even during his illness I would receive cheery phone calls from him and he came into school whenever he could, even during his illness. Fatima is well known for making wonderful cakes for the staff and has even brought in delicious home cooked chicken dishes for our lunch. She cooks the best couscous I have ever tasted!
