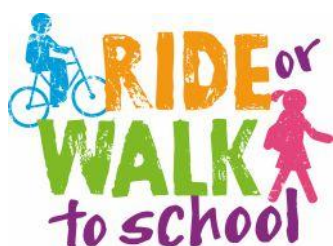


Outstanding payments to school
