**Please don't forget to send us in your family 'Half Term Learning Challenge' with the theme of 'My First Time'.**

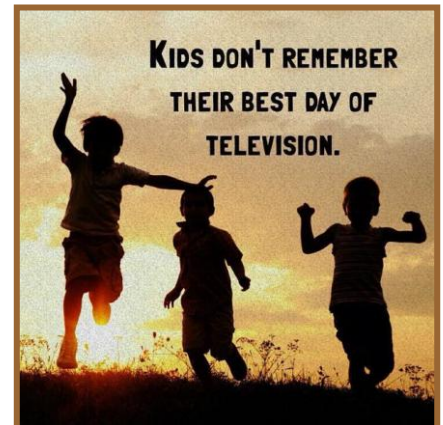
**Tell us about any activity your child or family has done for the first time!**



An article from **Action for Children** is inviting parents to take part in its 'National Children's Hour' campaign, which encourages families to 'unplug and play'. The campaign was launched in 2014 to coincide with the start of daylight saving time every year.

Findings from the Action for Children survey of parents revealed that, on average, UK families spend less than an hour (52 minutes) of 'quality, focused' time together each day because of parents' long working hours and challenging shift patterns, and children being distracted by digital technology.

**'Unplug and Play' sounds like a good motto for families to have!**

### Voluntary contributions

We ask every free funded parent to support us with a donation of £12 each half term to pay for the fruit and snacks the children have each day, cooking ingredients, gardening projects, additional resources we purchase for open sessions etc. This money is less than £2 a week but makes a vast difference to our budget and enables us to buy many extras for the children.
