**From Monday 6th November:** children in nursery need to apply for a **reception place**.

Applications open from this day if your child was born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014. You will receive an application pack from Herts County Council with details.

**So far only 31 out of 63 families have applied for a Reception place. Please be aware the closing date is Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018!**
