We are very fortunate that Susan Bayliss, a specialist Community Nursery Nurse, is coming to Kingswood on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October to talk to parents in confidence. This service is free and confidential.

Areas you may wish to discuss may include:

- Routine child development – eating habits.
- Emotional and social development – separation anxiety, sibling rivalry.
- Behaviour management – tantrums, setting boundaries.
- Language and Communication- language delay.
- Sleep difficulties, waking up at night.
- Toileting concerns, getting children out of nappies.
- ***Or any other aspects of your child's development***



Every parent will receive an individual letter to book a 45 minute slot. There are only 3 slots available!

Drawstring rucksacks, Notebooks, Pens, Crayons, Baseball caps, Towel & Wash cloths, Toothbrush and toothpaste, Vaseline, Sports shoes or flip-flops, socks, T-shirts/polo shirts, Underwear, Solar flashlight.

Filling the shoe box is a very rewarding activity to do with your child and gives them an understanding of helping others. **The boxes must be back by Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October for our walk to Stanborough Church.**

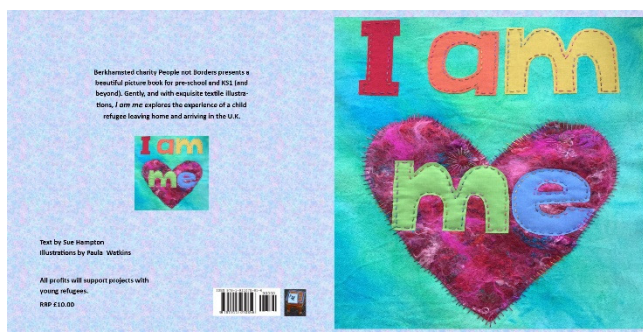
**One World Week**

It is written in a gentle way that children will be able to understand.



We would be thrilled if any parent or carer could come into school and tell us about customs and festivals that they follow at home. In the past we have had parents show us how to put on sari, bringing in foods linked to celebrations for us to taste, singing songs/telling stories from their culture, bringing in artefacts for us to look at.
