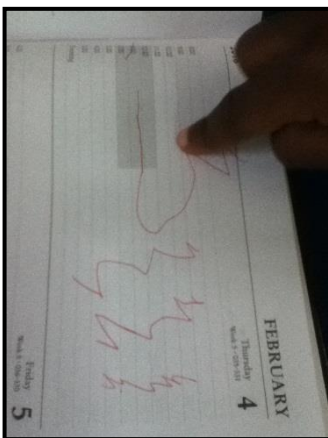

Over the last couple of weeks, we have been focusing on Maths and developing and seeking out ways that we use numbers in everyday situations. The children have been learning to count 1-1 correspondence to ensure their counting is accurate.

At home, take every opportunity to do lots of careful counting – touch each object as you count.

For example, counting out 6 bananas when shopping etc.
