E-Safety

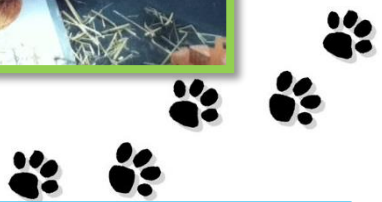
