Home Learning:

We have recently been focusing on Maths and developing and seeking out ways that we use numbers in everyday situations. The children have been learning to count 1-1 correspondence to ensure their counting is accurate.

At home, take every opportunity to do lots of careful counting – touch each object as you count.

For example, counting out 6 bananas when shopping etc.

Busy Fingers!

As many of you may have already noticed, we have started to rotate the groups around at the beginning of each session for 'busy fingers' as the children are now well settled. We believe this change is beneficial to avoid the classroom becoming overcrowded.
