Playdough Recipe

2 cups of plain flour

1 cup of salt

2 tablespoons of oil

2 cups of water

4 teaspoons of cream of tartar.

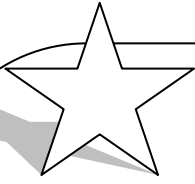
Mix all ingredients together in a saucepan. You may add food colouring, different spices or essences to alter the colour or scent of the dough. Heat the mixture on the hob until it forms the consistency of dough. Allow to cool, now play.
