Dear Parent/Carer,

Please may we ask for your cooperation in an important matter.

One of our pupils is receiving medical treatment for leukaemia which puts them at risk if they are exposed to measles, chicken pox, shingles or sickness bugs. In between treatments, and when he is well enough, we look forward to him joining his peers at school.

The best way to protect our pupil from measles is for all children at school to be immunised against this infection. Please would you discuss measles immunisation with your GP if your child has not already received this. If your child is suspected of having measles, you should let us know immediately.

Our pupil is also at risk from chicken pox and would need to be given an injection within three days of contact. If your child is suspected of having chicken pox you should let us know immediately.

It is also important that you let us know if there is shingles in your household.

It is vital that any cases of vomiting or diarrhoea are taken seriously; you must adhere to the Herts County Council policy and keep your child at home for forty-eight hours after the final bout of sickness and/or diarrhoea.

One of the best ways to spread any infection is through good handwashing, after toileting and before eating. Please ensure that these good habits are promoted at home as we do in school.

Your child is not at any risk whatsoever from this medical condition; however, the health and well-being of our pupil who is at risk, does depend on the co-operation of all other parents and we hope you will support us in helping to keep him well and join us in wishing him a speedy recovery.
