






Our Remote Learning Offer in the Event of Full Closure

We endeavour to remain open to provide quality learning and care for all the children at Kingswood, however during a global pandemic it is more vital than ever that we are prepared, and flexible, with regards to providing learning within a range of situations. This documents outlines our remote learning offer in the event of a whole school closure. This would happen if:

- A child or member of staff tested positive and we were instructed by Public Health England to close for a period of time
- VERY low levels of staffing levels made it unsafe to open to any children
- Local or national lockdown guidelines, or the Department for Education, instruct Maintained Nursery Schools to close

Outlined below is the daily routine that will be available for all children, in both Nursery and Pre-school, from the first day of closure, which we would encourage you to access with your child. **The tasks will go live at these times, but you do not have to join every activity at these times; they will be on Tapestry for you to access when and as often as you wish.** It would benefit your child to participate in as many of these as possible to ensure that they continue to develop and consolidate skills. In addition, regular participation will support a smoother transition upon returning to school.

<p><u>Teaching task</u></p> <p>Key Persons will take it in turns to lead an activity. Different subject areas will be covered throughout the week</p>	<p><u>Story time</u></p> <p>Get cosy, and ready to listen, whilst a key person reads a favourite story, and makes suggestions about what you could talk about together</p>	<p>Ask your children to help:</p> <p>Wipe down the table for lunch Count out the bowls, plates, cutlery for everyone eating Wash, chop, or peel fruit or vegetables Cut sandwiches, spoon equal amounts of rice into bowls etc. Pour water from a jug Wash, or dry up</p>	<p><u>Self-help challenge</u></p> <p>Support staff will set a task to develop your child's self-help skills, enabling them to become more independent.</p>	<p><u>Singing Session</u></p> <p>Join in with Number Rhymes, Nursery Rhymes and familiar songs with one of the key persons.</p>
