Later in term we will also have a Stay and Play session for you to join in with your child and participate in 'learning through play'!



Which is the best school for my child?



Consider:

- **Do you think your child will be more comfortable in a small or larger space?**
- **What access is there to the outdoor environment?**
- **What extended care is available?**
- **How are parents involved in the life of the school?**
- **Can you walk to school? Is it near enough for you and your child to feel part of the local community?**
- **Remember an Ofsted report is only a snapshot in time, it may be over 5 years old and reflect a school where many changes have since happened.**
- **Visit schools to decide if they 'feel' right. Most schools will hold open days for you to visit.**

Primary School Admissions Close 15th January 2024.

You must apply for school place by then if your child is in Nursery.

Nursery Admissions close 1st March 2024.

You must apply for a Kingswood Nursery place by then, if you have a younger child and wish them to attend Kingswood, or if your child is in Pre School and you wish them to continue their learning with us.
